INTRODUCING GRACE MINISTRIES IN ACTION

Grace Ministries in Action (GMA) is a Christian organization that seeks to build and train mature disciples of Christ and to support mercy projects that will increase the church's opportunity to share the love and grace of God. Our priorities focus on Christian leadership training and on special projects that create opportunities for sharing the gospel with an emphasis upon the Middle East and North Africa. GMA has a Board of Directors that oversees all projects and expenditures. GMA is a subsidiary organization of Allegro Solutions of Houston, a registered 501c3 organization in Texas. All financial contributions and receipting are handled through Allegro Solutions, and all donations to GMA are tax deductible. GMA has several sub-accounts for projects, and donors can choose which account they wish to give to.

Project 1: The Arab Center for Biblical Studies

GMA's premier project is the Arab Center for Biblical Studies (ACBS) located in a key country of the Middle East. This is a joint partnership ministry with BEE World (Biblical Education by Extension). The mission of ACBS is to train and equip Arabic speaking believers in the Middle East and North Africa using a curriculum of courses that have been translated into Arabic. The training is conducted online, and students are guided in their studies by mature and highly trained Arabic speaking Christian leaders. For more information about ACBS, visit www.arableaders.org. ACBS currently has an annual budget of \$54,000.



Project 2: Grace Medical Mission Clinic in Syria

Since 2017, GMA has been funding the operation of a medical clinic in western Syria. Staffed by Syrian Christian doctors in Syria, the clinic serves the many Syrian refugees that have been uprooted from their homes and left struggling. The clinic has an annual budget of \$24,000.

Project 3: Personal Support Account

As the Director of GMA and the Academic Dean of ACBS, Dr. Tanner receives a small periodic stipend for his services and to cover any ministry travel reimbursements. Hence, account "GMIAction.JPT" is set up for those who wish to help with his personal expenses.

How to Give

In an effort to avoid as much overhead expense as possible, Grace Ministries in Action operates as a subsidiary of Allegro Solutions in Houston, TX, a U.S. 501c3 organization.
