### HOSEA

#### *The Use of Hosea 1:6-10 & 2:23 in Romans 9 and 1 Peter 2*

HOSEA	ROMANS	1 PETER
<p>1:6 And the LORD said to him, "Name her Lo-ruhamah (no compassion), for I will no longer have <u>compassion</u> (MT = <b>רחם</b>; LXX = <i>ἐλεεω</i>) on the house of Israel, that I should ever forgive them."</p>		
<p>1:9 And the LORD said, "Name him Lo-ammi (not my people), for you are not My people and I am not your God."</p>		
<p>1:10 Yet the number of the sons of Israel will be like the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured or numbered.</p> <p>And it will come about that, in the place where it is said to them, "You are not My people," it will be said to them, "You are the sons of the living God."</p>	<p>9:26 And it shall be that in the place where it was said to them, "You are not My people." There they shall be called sons of the Living God.</p>	
<p>2:23 I will also have <u>compassion</u> (MT = <b>רחם</b>; LXX<sup>B</sup> = <i>ἀγαπάω</i>; Rahlfs = <i>ἐλεεω</i>) on her who had not obtained compassion, and I will say to those who were not My people, "You are My people!" And they will say, "Thou art my God!"</p>	<p>9:25 As He says also in Hosea, "I will call those who were not My people, 'My people,' And her who was not <u>beloved</u>, (Gk = <i>ἀγαπάω</i>) 'Beloved.'"</p>	<p>2:10 For you once were not a people, but now you are the people of God; you had not received <u>mercy</u> (Gk = <i>ἐλεεω</i>), but now you have received mercy.</p>
