## Nineveh's War Atrocities on Her Enemies

- She destroyed opponents' capital cities, completely demolishing them.
- She destroyed the idols and images of other cities.
- Her chariots raced wildly through the streets of other cities.
- 4. She routed the populations of other cities.
- 5. She plundered the wealth of other nations.
- 6. She left other cities in desolate ruins.
- 7. She caused many people to be in anguish.
- She burned the chariots of enemy cities.
- Her whips cracked, her chariot wheels rattled, her horses galloped, and her chariots bounded in other cities.
- She massacred masses of people and piled up the bodies.
- 11. She threw filth on her captives.
- She exhibited captive leaders as a spectacle before her people.
- 13. She made others drunk with anguish.
- She caused people of other cities to search futilely for a refuge from her armies, fleeing for their lives.
- She burned the gates and buildings of many other cities.
- 16. She besieged many other cities.
- She cut down other people with the sword, including their leaders.

## Nineveh's Destruction by Her Enemies

- Now a complete end is to be made of her, a capital city (1:8-9).
- Now her idols and images are to be destroyed (1:14).
- 3. Now chariots of enemy nations are to race through her streets (2:4).
- Now her people are to be routed and to flee from the city (2:8).
- 5. Now her wealth is to be plundered (2:9).
- Now she is to be emptied and left in desolate ruins (2:10).
- 7. Now she is to be in anguish (2:10).
- 8. Now her chariots are to be burned (2:13).
- Now these sounds are to be heard in her city (3:2).
- Now many of her people are to be slain, and countless dead bodies to be left in her city (3:3).
- 11. Now filth is to be thrown on her people (3:6).
- 12. Now she is to be gazed on by others (3:6).
- 13. Now she is to be made drunk with anguish (3:11).
- 14. Now her people are to search futilely for a refuge from her enemies, fleeing for their lives (3:11,17).
- Now her city gates and buildings are to be burned (3:13,15).
- 16. Now she is to be besieged (3:14).
- 17. Now her people are to be cut down with the sword, including her leaders (3:15,18).
